Getting Started

In order to install this child theme, you must first **purchase a membership to Elegant Themes** and download the Divi theme package.

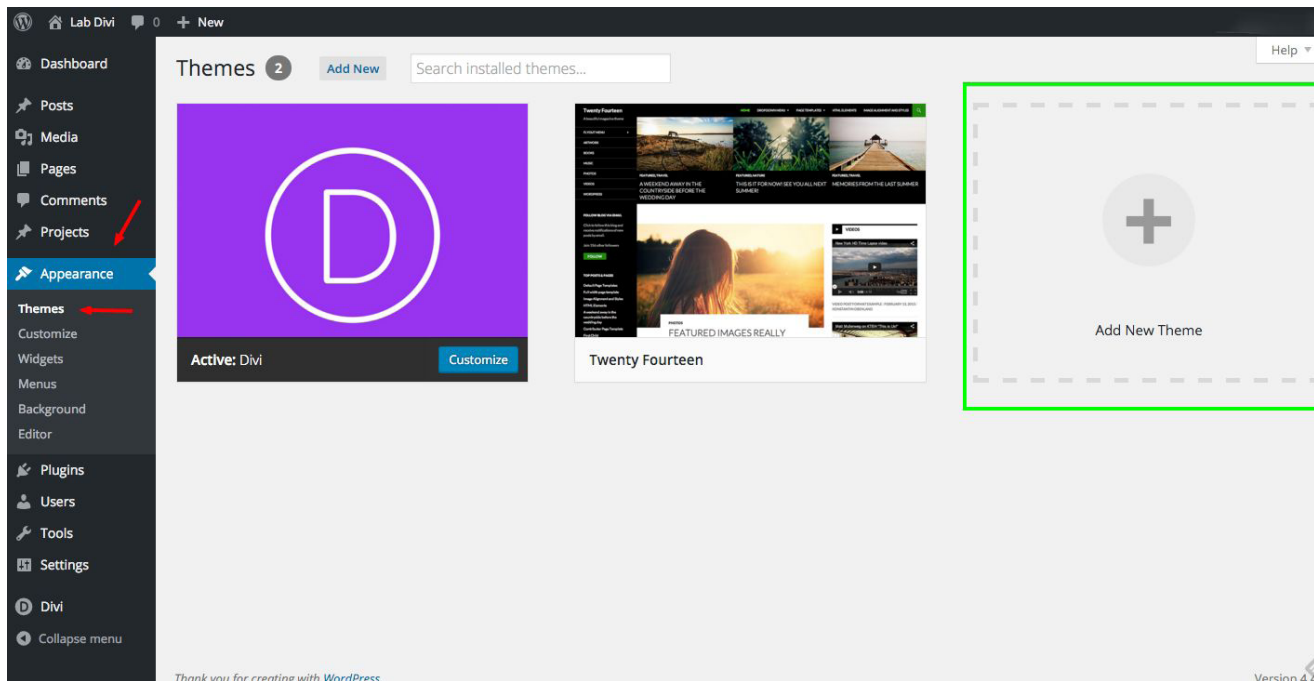

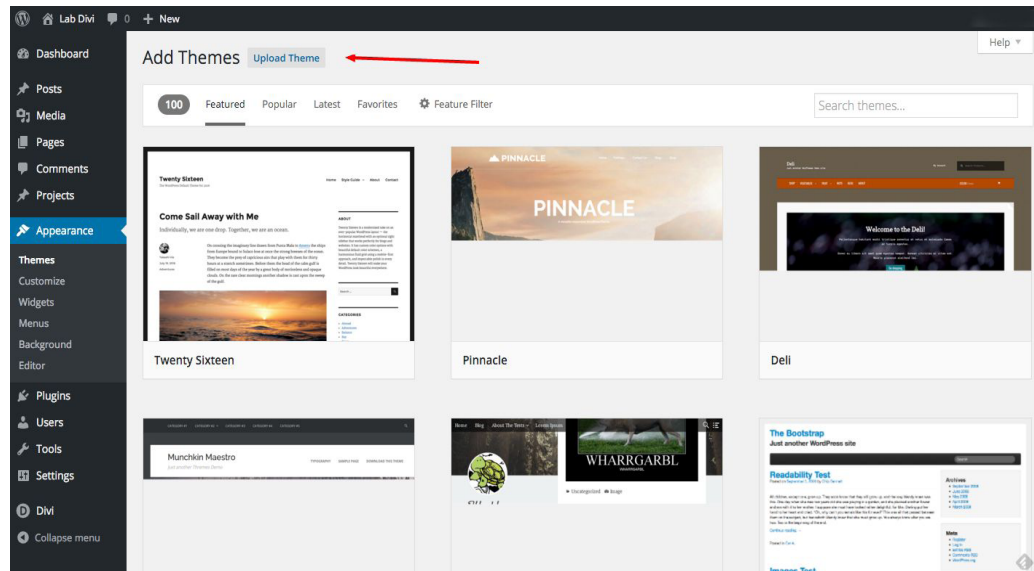
1 INSTALLING CHILD THEME

#Step 1: Once you've downloaded the Divi theme package, login to your Wordpress website and go to **Appearance > Themes**. Find and upload the Divi parent theme and activate it.

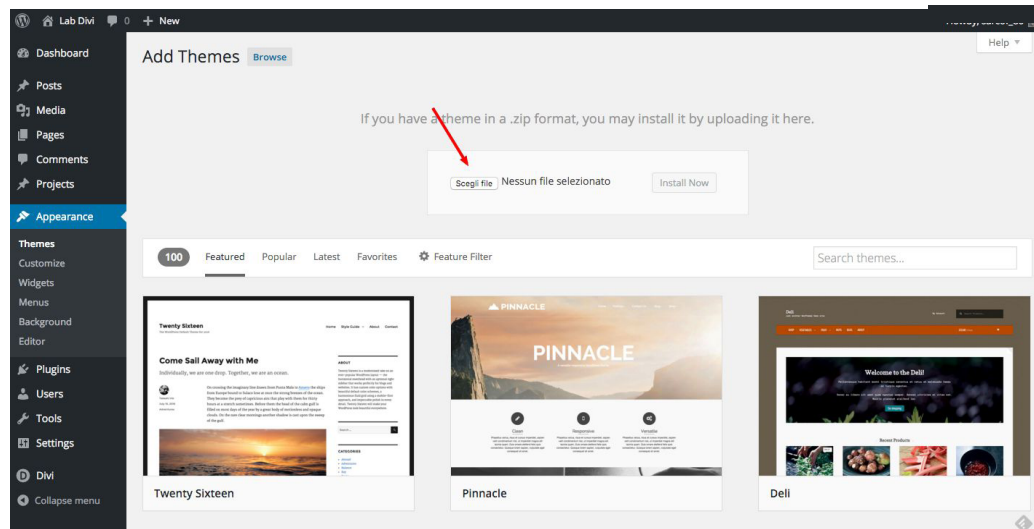
Next click on the **Add New Theme**.



#Step 2: Click on Upload Theme.




#Step 3: Click on Choose file.



#Step 4: In the downloaded package find and select the file Bruno.zip, then click on the **Install Now** button.

Completing the upload, you will need to activate the theme by clicking on the **Activate**.

#Step 5: Install Plugins

BRUNO Theme requires 5 plugins:

Caldera Forms, Recent Post Widget With Thumbnails, Typing Effect and One Click Demo Import.

We have made installing process very simple. After BRUNO Child Theme is activated system will ask you to install all missed plugins. Click **Begin installing plugins**.

This theme requires the following plugins: [Caldera Forms - Drag and drop responsive WordPress form builder](#), [One Click Demo Import](#), [Recent Post Widget Thumbnail](#) and [Typing Effect](#).

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INSTALLING DEMO CONTENT

#Step 1: Now you will need to install the library and all theme settings which allows you to have your site just like the demo version.

Go to **Appearance > Import Data Demo**, and click on the **Import Demo Data** button.

Before you begin, make sure all the required plugins are activated.

Importing demo data (post, pages, images, theme settings, ...) is the easiest way to setup your theme. It will allow you to quickly edit everything instead of creating content from scratch.

When you import the data, the following things might happen:

- No existing posts, pages, categories, images, custom post types or any other data will be deleted or modified.
- Posts, pages, images, widgets and menus will get imported.
- Please click "Import Demo Data" button only once and wait, it can take a couple of minutes.

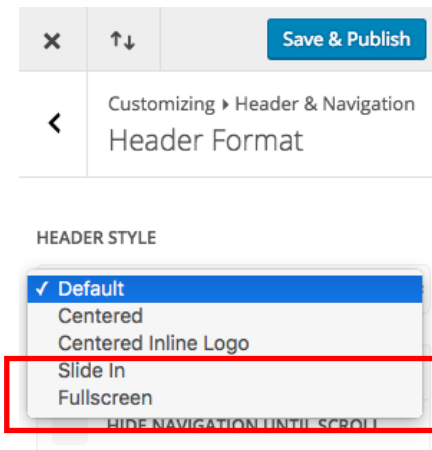
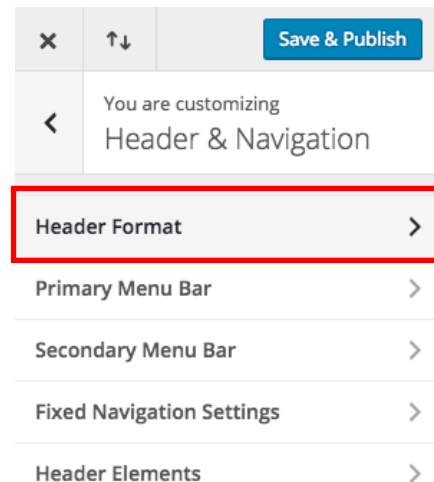
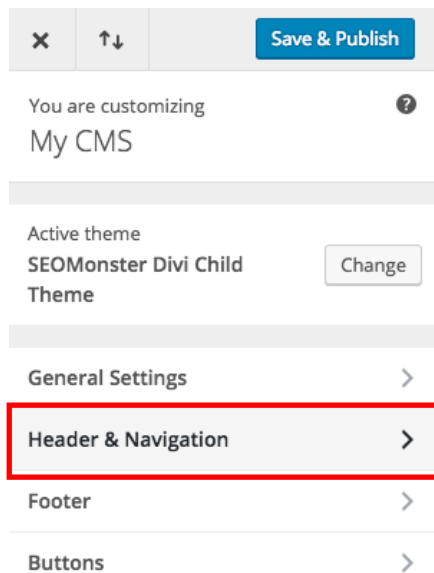
#Step 2: In many cases imported settings in previous step don't apply automatically and we have a white background on the header. To enable transparent header we need to overwrite header settings.

Go to **Divi > Theme Customizer**.

Click **Header & Navigation > Header Format**

Select from Dropdown menu **Fullscreen** and click **Save & Publish**.

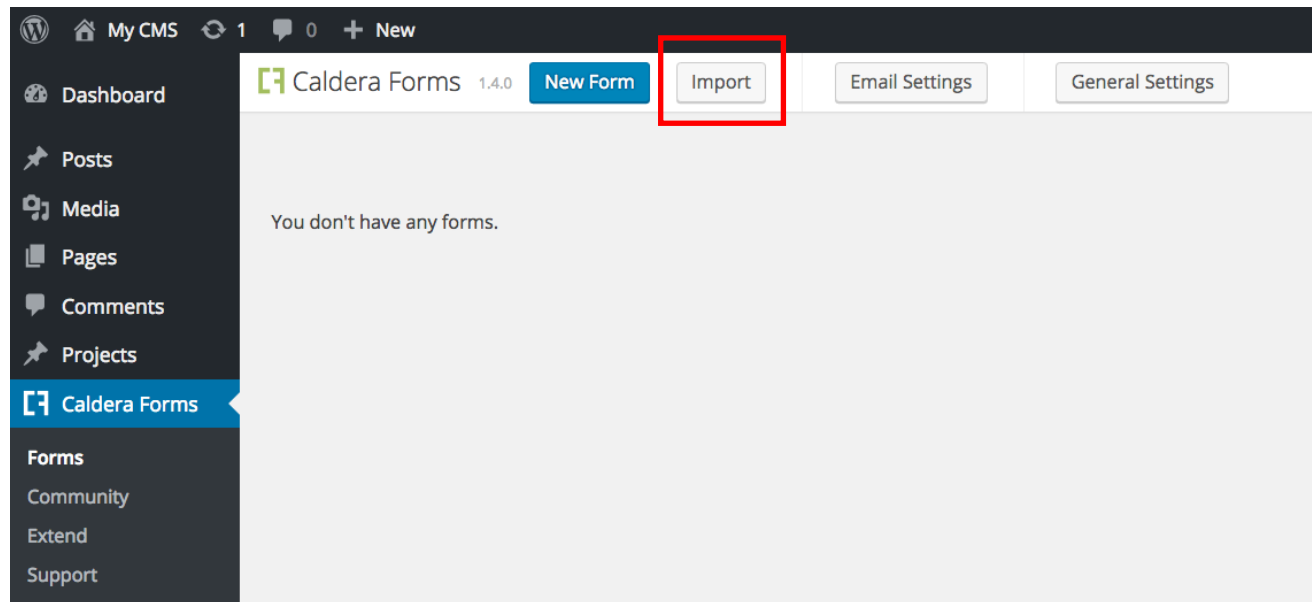
Now change back to **Default** and click **Save & Publish**



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IMPORTING CALDERA FORMS

#Step 1: The theme has 1 pre-built form. It needs to be imported from download package. Go to the **Caldera Forms** tab in your WordPress Dashboard and click **Import** button. Select “contact-form.json” file located in “Contact Form Import” folder and click **Import** button.






SETTING UP PERMALINKS

To make the Contact Form Popup working,
Permalinks Settings have to be setup to “Post name”.

Go to **Settings > Permalinks**

Select “Post name” and click **Save Changes**.
