



# ZARA DOCUMENTATION

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Thank you for Purchasing ZARA, premium child theme for Divi Theme. This can be installed as a child theme or simply import the Layouts into your Divi Library to use however you'd like in your own Divi site or Divi Builder plugin.

In this file you will find step-by-step instructions explaining both how to install the child theme and/or import the layouts to your Divi Library.

## **Getting Started**

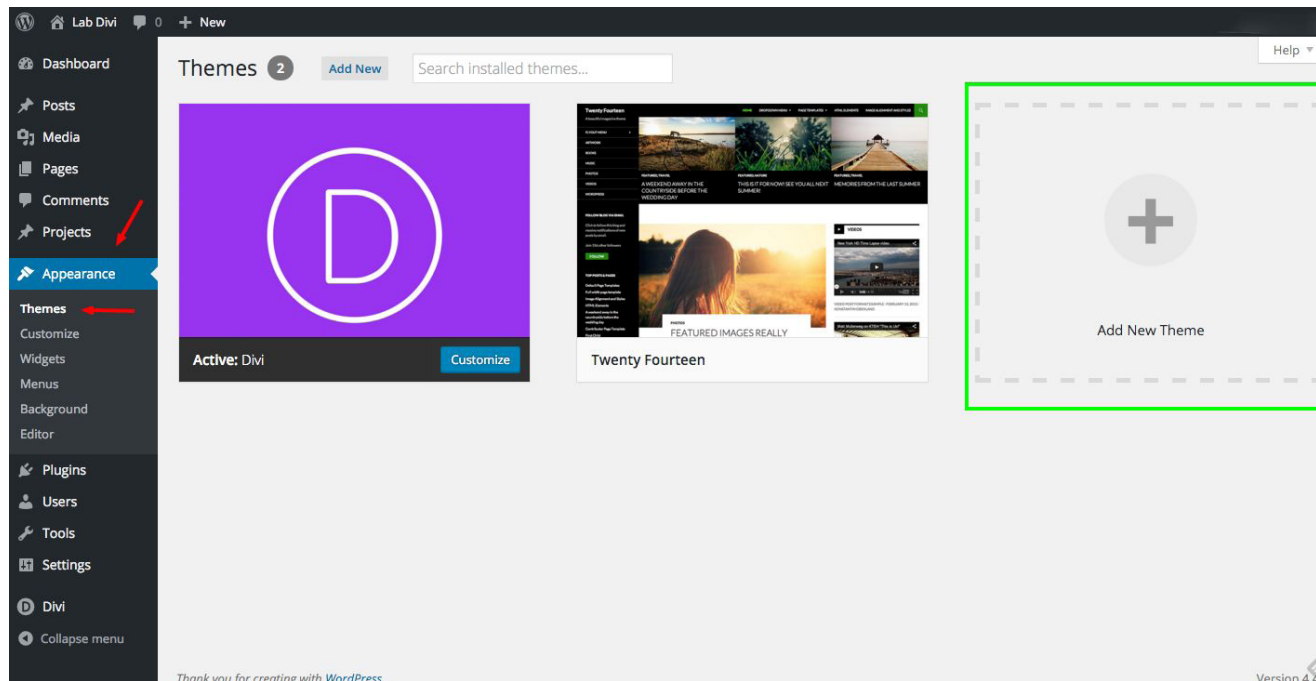
In order to install this child theme, you must first [purchase a membership to Elegant Themes](#) and download the Divi theme package.

This version of ZARA is fully compatible with versions 2.7+. Some features or elements, may not be compatible with previous versions. So please ensure that you've downloaded the latest version of Divi.

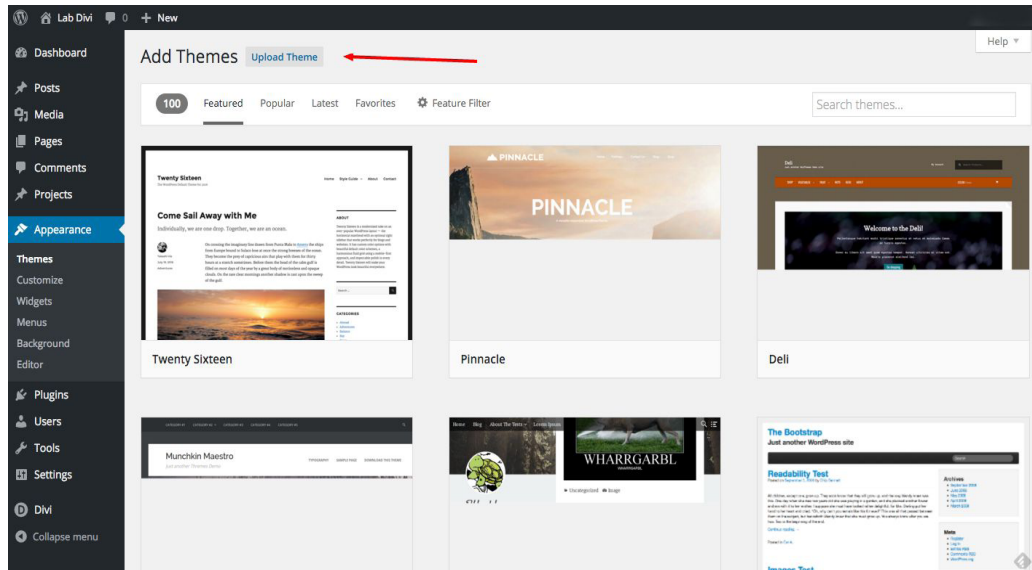
# **1** INSTALLING CHILD THEME

**#Step 1:** Once you've downloaded the Divi theme package, login to your Wordpress website and go to **Appearance > Themes**. Find and upload the Divi parent theme and activate it.

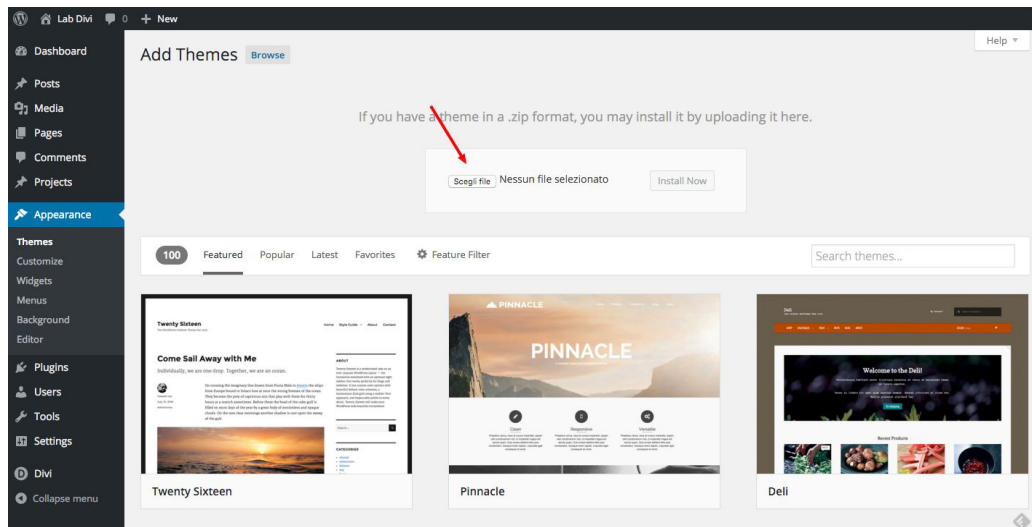
Next click on the **Add New Theme**.



## #Step 2: Click on Upload Theme.

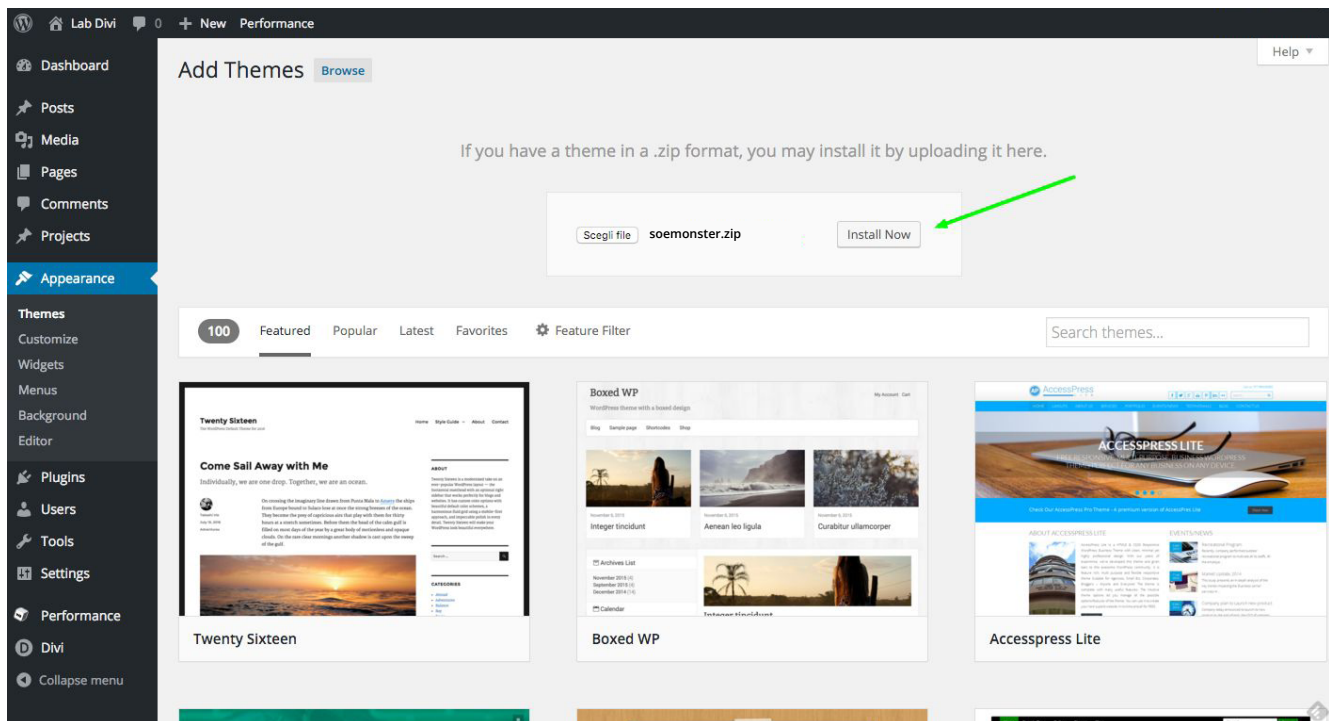


## #Step 3: Click on Choose file.



#Step 4: In the downloaded package find and select the file Zara.zip, then click on the **Install Now** button.

Completing the upload, you will need to activate the theme by clicking on the **Activate**.



## #Step 5: Install Plugins

ZARA Theme requires 6 plugins: Caldera Forms, Master Slider PRO, Recent Post Widget With Thumbnails, AccessPress Twitter Feed and One Click Demo Import.

We have made installing process extremely easy. After ZARA child theme is activated system will ask you to install all missed plugins. Click **Begin installing plugins**.

This theme requires the following plugins: [Caldera Forms - Drag and drop responsive form builder](#), [Master Slider - Responsive Touch Slider](#), [One Click Demo Import](#), [Recent Posts Widget With Thumbnails](#) and [Twitter Feed for WordPress - AccessPress Twitter Feed](#).

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## INSTALLING DEMO CONTENT



#Step 1: Now you will need to install the library and all theme settings which allows you to have your site just like the demo version.

Go to **Appearance > Import Data Demo**, and click on the **Import Demo Data** button.

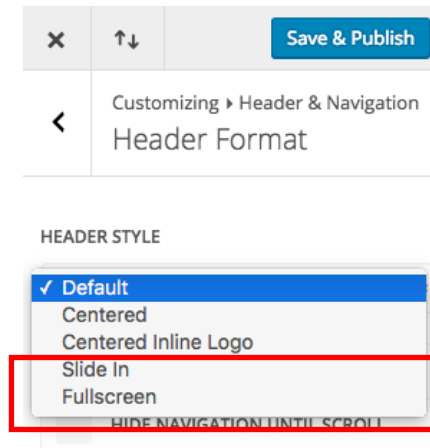
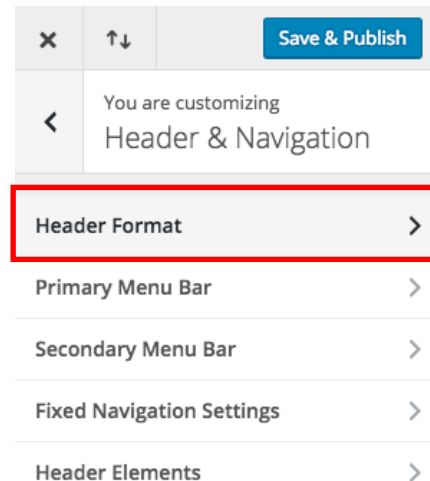
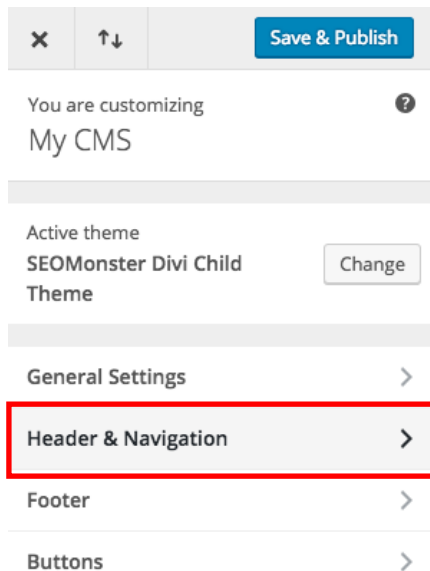
**#Step 2:** In many cases imported settings in previous step don't apply automatically (skip this step if you do not see this issue on your site) and we have an issue with the header. To enable transparent header we need to overwrite header settings.

Go to **Divi > Theme Customizer**.

Click **Header & Navigation > Header Format**

Select from Dropdown menu **Fullscreen** and click **Save & Publish**.

Now change back to **Default** and click **Save & Publish**



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## IMPORTING MASTER SLIDER SETTINGS

Go to the MasterSlider tab in your WordPress Dashboard and click **Import/Export** button. Click **Choose File** and select masterslider-specials-import.json file located in Import Files folder, click **Import**.

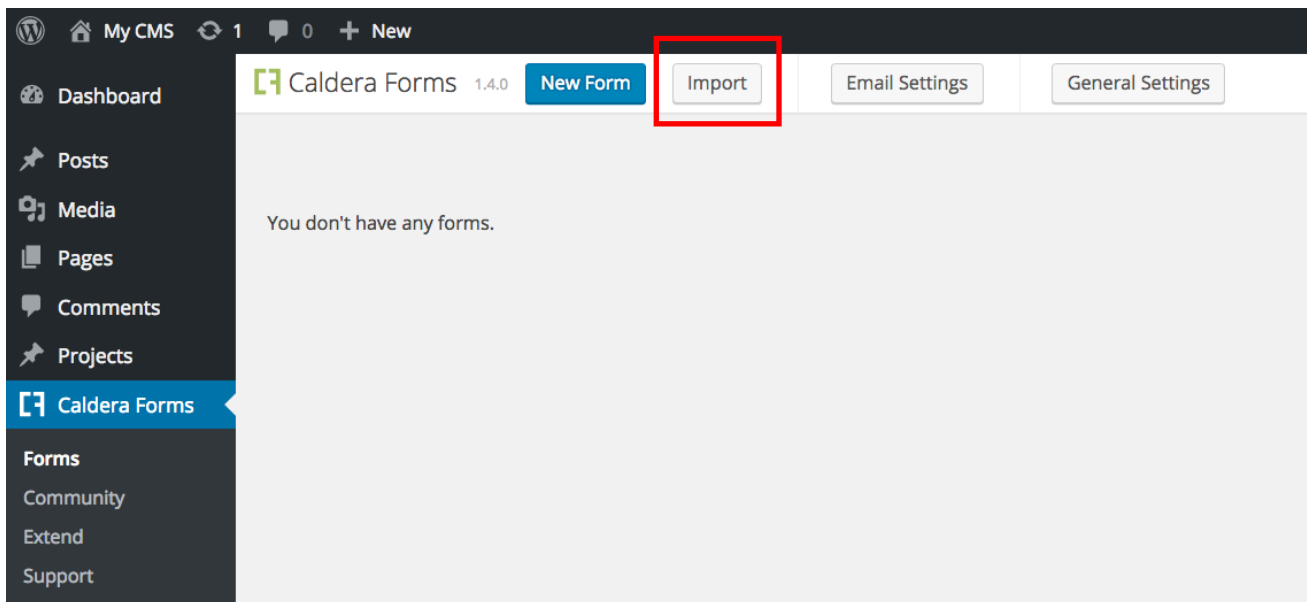

## IMPORTING CALDERA FORMS FILES

**#Step 1:** The theme has 2 forms: booking form and contact form. They both need to be imported from download package. Go to the **Caldera Forms** tab in your WordPress Dashboard and click **Import** button. Select “Caldera-booking-form.json” file located in Import Files folder and click **Import** button. Follow the same steps above by locating Caldera-contact-form.json.



# **5** **SETTING UP PERMALINKS**

To make the Reservation Form Popup working,  
Permalinks Settings have to be setup to “Post name”.

Go to **Settings > Permalinks**

Select “Post name” and click **Save Changes**.
